Frodo must do everything he can to prevent this, and with the help of Gandalf the wizard and a band of loyal companions, he begins a perilous journey across Middle-earth. Sauron's Black Riders are on their trail as they travel to Rivendell, attempt to cross the snow-swept Misty Mountains, and, in desperation, enter the terrifying Mines of Moria.
